COURSE OVERVIEW

The Emergency Nurses Association has developed a nationally standardized basic trauma nursing class, the Trauma Nursing Core Course (TNCC).

It is designed to establish a consistent knowledge base for nurses involved in the initial care of the trauma patient.

The TNCC provides two days of review and evaluation of basic trauma nursing knowledge and skills, specific areas of injury and other trauma topics are discussed in the morning lectures. Skill station evaluation and the written examination are completed the second afternoon.

The TNCC is presented by state faculty selected by the Trauma Committee of the Michigan Council of the Emergency Nurses Association.

FAQ

WHO CAN TAKE THE TNCC?

- Any RN interested in improving their trauma nursing skills. (The authors recommend a minimum of 6 months experience in the emergency setting.)
- Other Health Care Providers (EMT's; EMT-P's, etc.) may attend the Lecture & Psychomotor Skill Stations as "AUDITORS". They may not participate in Day 2 Testing and do not receive a verification card. Dismissal will be at 1230 hours on Day 2.
- EMT's, EMT-P's & EMT-Specialists are pre-approved for 16 CE's thru the State of Michigan.

DO I HAVE TO PREPARE FOR THIS CLASS?

- Because this is a course where your knowledge and skills are evaluated, advance preparation is recommended. You will receive your manual 30 days prior to your course.

WHAT DO I GET WHEN I COMPLETE THE TNCC?

- The course is approved for 14.42 CECH. Contact hours can only be given for actual time attended. If successful in all evaluations, a TNCC CECH Certificate and an ENA TNCC Provider verification card will be issued.

HOW MUCH DOES THE TNCC COST?

- The fee for the 2-day course is: \$300.00 (The fee includes the provider manual)
- Refund policy: NO REFUNDS. Fee may be applied to a future course with an additional \$100.00 rescheduling fee.
